# **INFORMATION ABOUT OUR USE OF COOKIES**

Our website uses cookies (small files of letters and numbers we store on your browser, or hard drive)

- to distinguish you from other users;
- help us provide you with a more personal and convenient website visit;
- and enable us to identify ways to improve our site.

By continuing to browse our site you are agreeing to the use of these cookies.

We use the following cookies:

#### STRICTLY NECESSARY COOKIES

These are required for the operation of our website and include cookies that enable you to log into secure areas, use a shopping cart or make use e-billing services.

# **ANALYTICAL/PERFORMANCE COOKIES**

These allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors and see how visitors move around our website when using it. This helps us improve the way our website works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily.

### **FUNCTIONAL COOKIES**

These recognise you when you return to our website, enabling us to personalise our content for you, greet you by name and remember your preferences (for example, your choice of language or region).

## **TARGETING COOKIES**

These cookies record your visit to our website, the pages you've visited and the links you've followed. We use this information to make our website, and the advertising displayed on it, more relevant to your interests. We may also share this information with third parties for this purpose.

Please note that third parties (including, for example, advertising networks and providers of external services like web traffic analysis services) may also use cookies, over which we have no control.

These cookies are likely to be analytical/performance cookies or targeting cookies which you can block by activating the setting on your browser that allows you to refuse the some or all cookies.

However, if you use your browser settings to block all cookies (including essential cookies) you may not be able to access all or parts of our website.
